NURSERY RHYME

PROJECT BRIEF

In the areas indicated as on the assignment sheet depict each phrase of the nursery rhymes: "Hey Diddle Diddle," "Humpty Dumpty," and "The Old Woman Who Lived in a Shoe," by creating a narrative that expresses each rhyme using only given dingbats (ornaments), symbols, pictograms, and engravings on Assignment Sheet as your vocabulary for final form, and composition.

*Images are to be in half-tone rather than as gray scale.

SUGGESTIONS

Given the nonsensical nature of each of the nursery rhymes aim is to freely use images in allegorical context. The nursery rhymes are the known, lacking in newness, energy and spontaneity. By reinterpreting time- work images aim is revitalize a prosaic idea and give it power once possessed.

DELIVERABLES

- 4 pieces of b&w 297 x 297 mm print out on normal paper
- Process book
- OSS Process and Portfolio submission

AIM

The aim is to move beyond cliche solutions and habitual reaction to problem solving that leads to predictable results. Here goal is to manipulate, alter and deconstruct the give graphic imagery to transcend its original meaning through the creation of the indicated narratives. It is in the limitation of the given visual vocabulary that would challenge beyond habitual and literal problem solving and embrace the graphic palette where one and play and re-invent new imagery. The old engraving imagery puts the composition into historical context.

SPECIFICATION

The project will be done digitally with photoshop, in black & white (no colour). Students will come up with variations based on chosen rhyme. Each final composition should be 297mm x 297mm (4 pieces). Print and trim each composition on A3 size normal paper. Please note that source files have to be high in resolution with at least 300 dpi in A4 size.


