2. Submit daily health / temperature declarations

# Daily Temperature Declarations

- Making daily temperature / health declarations is one of the many socially responsible actions that we need to be mindful of.
- This helps us to be more conscious of our health and well-being.
- It will also help the authorities determine when someone may have had an onset of symptoms of COVID-19, which is a key piece of information to facilitate contact tracing



# Updating Travel Plans

- Should you need to travel (for personal reasons), please ensure that you update your plans in the travel declaration portal.
- International students, in particular, may require a letter from the University to enable them to re-enter Singapore.
