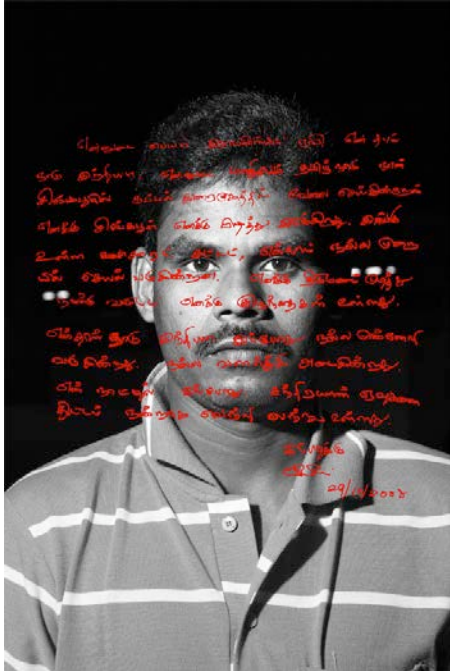

Synopsis:

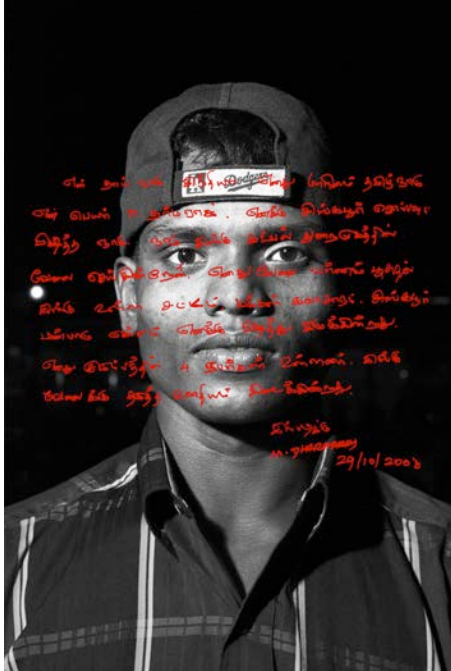

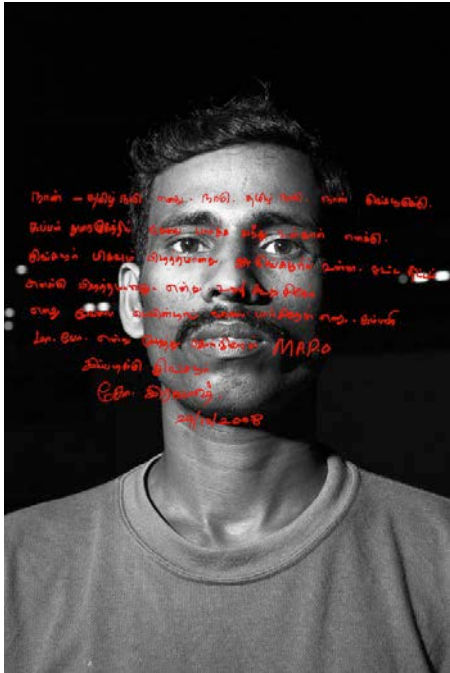
My name is Ramalingam Ravi.
