TAN TAN TAN TAN KEONG SAIK

Keong Saik Road was officially named in 1926 after Tan Keong Saik, a Malacca-born businessman who co-founded the Straits Steamship Company. Tan owned a number of houses in the vicinity of Keong Saik Road. Apart from Tan's residences, a number of charcoal and grocery wholesalers groceries stood alongside with coffee shops and incense retailers.

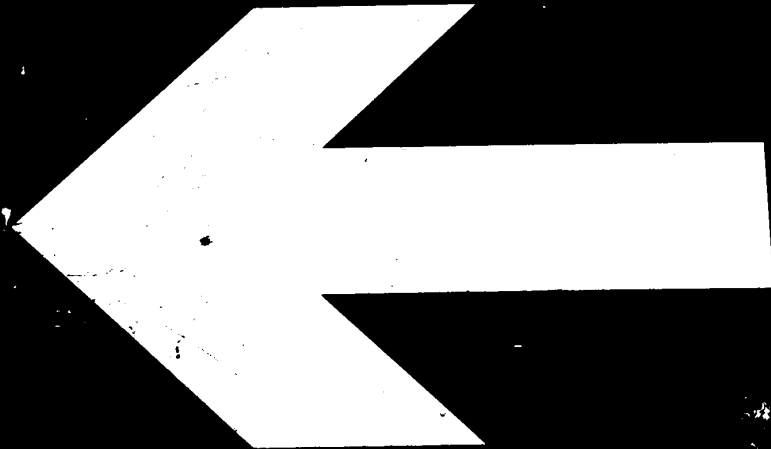
