Telok Blangah only hosts 1 Neighbourhood Police Post, 1 Red Rhino and 1 Ambulance near Telok Blangah Community Centre. Its emergency vehicles are readily deployable, so do watch out for these vehicles and remember to give way to them!

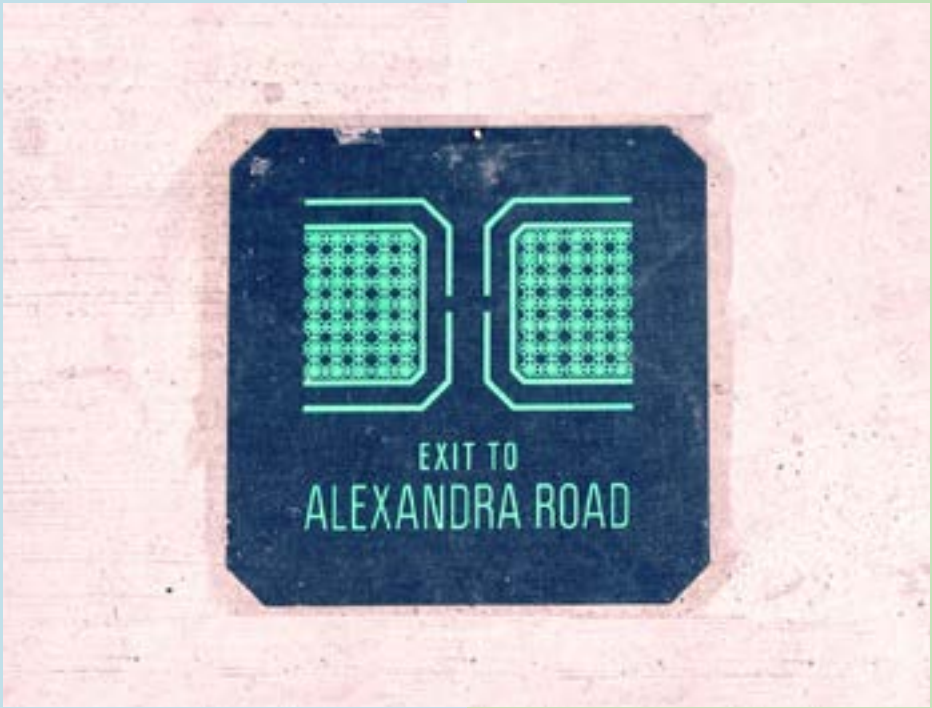
