

OSS Quick Guide: Overview of the Class Site

In this guide, you will learn how to access the class site

Steps / Action Descriptions

1. On each **CLASS SITE**, the left sidebar lists all enrolled students in the course.
2. Click on the **NAME** of the student you want to access his/her site.
3. The middle panel displays all the recent posting from the students in chronological order.
4. On each posting, click on the **TITLE** of the post or the **FEATURE IMAGES** to access your student's full posting.
