

OSS Quick Guide: Making a Post (II)

In this guide, you will learn how to publish the content and images for your post

Steps / Action Descriptions

1. Assign a **CATEGORIES** to your post for it to appear in the right section of your site.
2. Create and assign **TAGS** to your post for ease of searching and filtering.
3. Click on the **SET FEATURED IMAGE** button in the lower right-hand side of the editor and select an image.
4. Click on the **PUBLISH** button in the upper right-hand corner of the editor to publish your post.
