




## Sea Sand **Actor Positions:** Friend moves in 2. Friend moves out 3. Wife moves in Other actors' movement: - Couple in the water - Children walk to the sea





## Some notes

For this sequence of shots, we can see a beginning, middle, and end:

- 1. Friend approaches a seated lifeguard (LG).
- 2. LG peering over his friend's shoulder.
- 3. Person in the distance also **appearing over his friend's shoulder.**
- 4. **LG's reacts, stands up** on the beach, to have a better view of what's happening in the distance.
- 5. Couple 'reacts', stands up in the water, to reveal what's actually happening.
- 6. Friend leaves a seated lifeguard, and a new arc starts:
- Wife approaches a seated LG to say that the children don't have to play in the water if that worries him
- Children are playing in the water
- ...What could go wrong?
