It is a small installation (probably nothing bigger than A3), where I have a sand sculpture on top of a funnel thing. There will be a hole at the bottom of the funnel, so the sand sculpture will slowly disintegrate as the sand falls through the funnel, similar to the concept of an hour glass. As the sand drips out slowly, the artwork will slowly disappear within a stipulated time (less than 10 minutes) Asynchronous sound played beside the sand sculpture.

Beside the artwork there will be a computer, playing a video of a prerecorded version of the sand sculpture falling, but in rewind mode. (Edit the video so the sand goes up and then down, video can turn upside down, in contrast to measurable time/linear time in the actual installation.)
