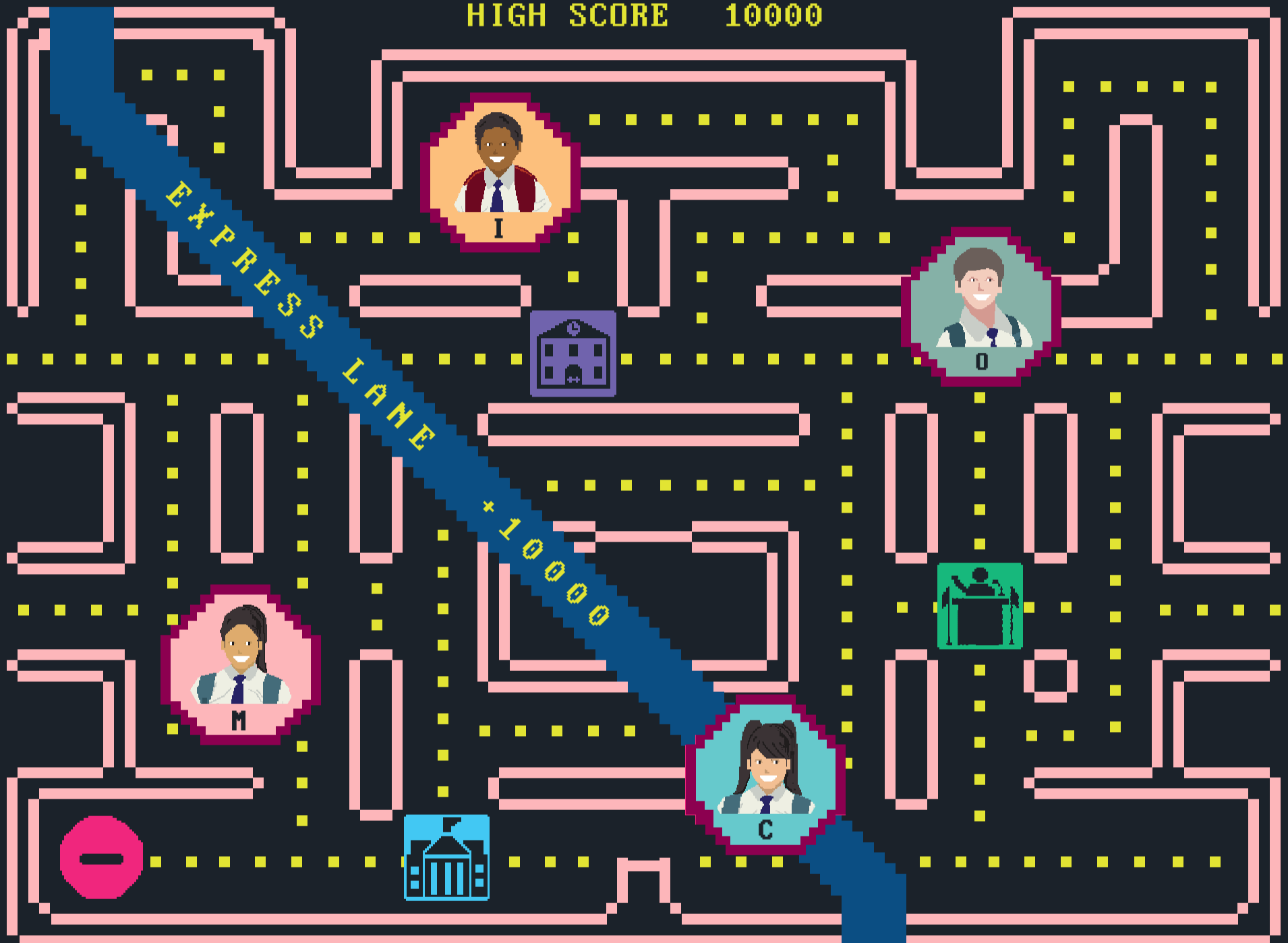
Racial Privilege is an advantage that is granted or available only to a particular person or group based on race.
