

The page you are directed to when you open the app.


See **updates** from people you follow.

## Search Page




The page you can search and explore.

Select the photos or video you would want to posts.


Tools such as **cropping**, **boomerang**, **collage** and **multiple photos**.

## 100 words Report



I use Instagram daily to check on updates from people I follow, post my own content and scroll through content in the search page. I feel the app is quite convenient. From being able to easily transition to different pages to the accessibility of the functions provided. The design of the app provides good usability to the respective pages without annoying or confusing the user.

An example, the app assists the user through the editing functions but gives the user the chance to figure out how and whether they want to use them.

Same goes with scrolling through content in the search page. First displaying them in a viewable 3x3 collage of previews, only when the user clicks on one of them, it enables the user to scroll from one post to the next without having to back out from the post back to the previews.
